THE PROMISE

Gen. 18V14 "Is anything too hard for the Lord? I will return to you at the appointed time next year and Sarah will have a son."

God spoke to Abraham and said: "Is anything too hard for God?". Many times, we receive divine promises from God which seems impossible to attain when we consider our circumstances, position, recourses, ability, etc.

However, throughout the corridors of time, we note that the same situation existed with many of God's servants.

Abraham found himself in the impossible situation of being well on in age as well as his wife Sarah being barren and also well on in age and God giving Abraham the promise that he would be the father of many nations and through him, God's blessing will flow.

Today we are still benefiting from Abraham's attitude towards God's promise.

Perhaps you are also faced with many negative issues surrounding your life, but like Abraham, I want to encourage you to hold on, journey the journey of faith with patience hoping that God who promised is faithful to fulfil His promise.

God is not limited by time or circumstances.

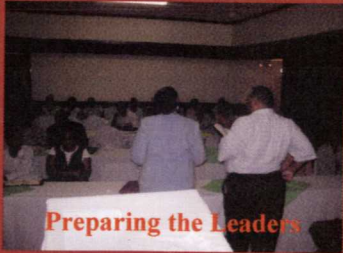


Lesotho Revival Crusade

A man Healed by God

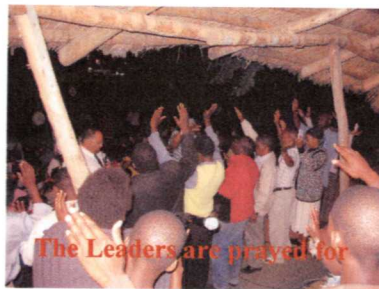

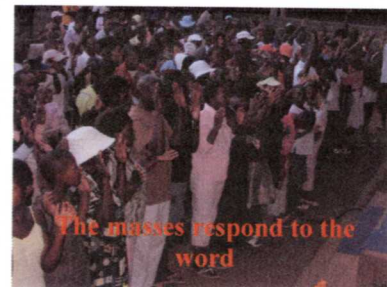
God moved mightily during the four days as many people were healed, saved, delivered and restored. The churches also united in a wonderful way which was truly an example to the community.

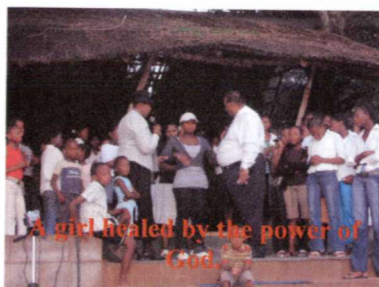
